It is hereby notified for information of all concerned that the receipt of admission forms, fee and dates for the commencement of ULB (Part-I, II & III) Annual Examination, 2019 for the fresh and failed candidates have been fixed as under:-

1.	Date of Commencement of Examination	= 10-02-2020	(Monday)
2.	Last Date for receipt of Admission forms without late fee	= 16-12-2019	(Monday)
3.	Last Date for receipt of Admission forms with late fee Rs.2000/-	= 24-12-2019	(Tuesday)
4.	Last Date for receipt of admission forms with Double fee Rs.8000/-	= 02-01-2020	(Thursday)
5.	Last Date for receipt of admission forms with Tripple fee Rs.12000/-	= 30-01-2020	(Thursday)

## 7. Eligibility:

- All the fresh candidates who are enrolled in affiliated colleges are eligible to appear in First Annual Examination, 2019.
  - i. The colleges/departments are required to submit affiliation letter and Registration return without any objection.
- The failed candidates of LLB (Part-I, II & III) who appeared in Supplementary Examination, 2018 and prior thereto and those who have chances at their credit can submit their admission forms and fee according to above schedule.
- All Rules and Regulations of IUB Bachelor of Laws (Three Years) Examination Rules 2016 under annual system of Examination are implemented accordingly.

# 8. Rules:

### IUB Bachelor of Laws (Three Years) Examination Rules 2016 under Annual System of Examinations.

"8. A candidate who does not appear in the first annual examination, or having appeared in the first annual examination has failed, may be allowed to appear in the next four examinations [within a period of three years or such time/times within which the four examinations are conducted] after his first failure/nor-appearance without attending a fresh course of lectures. A candidate who is unable to pass the examination within the period shall neither be admitted in LLB, nor allowed to appear privately"

### 9. Submission of admission forms and fee:

NAT is mandatory.

Admission forms and examination fee challan must be submitted to the Controller Office within the due dates fixed for the receipt of admission forms and fee mentioned above. All the female and male candidates are directed to affix their own one attested passport size recent photograph as well as original bank challan of fee on the admission form. Incomplete forms and the forms received after the last date will not be entertained.

#### Note:

- 1. The candidates who were appeared in Supplementary Examination, 2018 are directed to submit the admission forms which were dispatched to their colleges and on their given addresses (In case of Private Candidates) after filling all the fields of admission forms.
- 2. The admission forms of regular students of affiliated colleges must be submitted ( hard copies of admission form along with all required documents) duly verified and attested within stipulated date.
- 3. External candidates can submit their admission forms directly to the office of the Controller of Examinations, IUB.
- 4. The admission fee can be deposited in any nearest HBL Branch, challan form can be downloaded from university website (www.iub.edu.pk).
