## **NOTIFICATION:**

### **Split Conduct of Practical Examination:**

Consequent upon the meeting of Academic Committee of Balochistan Board of Intermediate & Secondary Education held on 16-5-2018, duly approved by the BOARD (Executive Body) in its 88<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> July, 2018, the Balochistan Board of Intermediate & Secondary Education is pleased to notify the split conduct of practical examination at SSC & HSSC level with the following procedure:

1. As part I practical exam of SSC & HSSC was not conducted in Annual 2018, therefore, composite practical exam of concerned students will be conducted in Annual 2019. There will be single practical paper of part I & part II of each subject.
2. Fresh students of part I (SSC and HSSC) will have to appear in their practical exam in Annual 2019 and there will be no composite exam of part I & II after Annual 2019.
3. Split practical exam will be conducted both of part I and part I & II combined (Both SSC & HSSC) in Annual 2019, i.e. a theoretical part regarding practical course (40%) and a practical/performance part (60%)
4. The theoretical part will be conducted through MCQ based Question papers of all the practicals in a separate session during theory exam.
5. The practical part of exam will be conducted by concerned teacher as home exam i.e. each teacher will conduct exam of the students whom he/she has taught the relevant subject during that particular session.
6. Break up of marks of theoretical and practical part will be as under:

#### **I. SSC level:**

7. Private candidates (failure and marks improving students) could only appear in theoretical part while marks of practical/performance awarded first time by the concerned teacher in home exam will remain the same and could not be improved.
8. Candidates, coming from other boards and those appearing for marks improvement and failures (of annual/bi-annual, 2018) in annual 2019 and onward, will also appear only in the theoretical part and average marks will be awarded for the whole practical. However, candidates those appearing for marks improvement will be allowed to opt improvement in theory only or theory and practical both.
9. Model Question papers for theoretical part of practical exam and instructions of practical/performance part will be conveyed soon to all the affiliated institutions and same will be uploaded on Board's website (www.bbise.edu.pk)
10. Remuneration for the conduct of practical/performance exam will be paid to the concerned teacher with the following rates:

HSSC: Rs. 30 / Student / Subject

SSC: Rs. 25 / Student / Subject

It is to inform all the affiliated Colleges that BISE, Quetta has decided to take practical exam in two parts from Annual 2019 onward. Details of which are as under:

**Part 1** (40%) MCQs type paper, based on practical related questions, marks of which for separate 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> classes will be 06 each and in 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> combined will be 12. (Model papers are attached).

**Part 2** (60%) This test will be taken by the concerned teacher who teaches the relevant subject to the class and that the same teacher will award the marks. In class 1<sup>st</sup> year and 2<sup>nd</sup> year separate, marks will be 09 each, while 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> combined will be (18) in annual 2019 exam. These marks will be distributed in the following way.

1. Every examiner will fill the attached pro-forma with the following manner and send to the Board office through Principal.

2. Head of the institute will be authorized to make 10% changes in marks and every page of result, has to be countersigned by him/her.
3. Before the end of the session, Board office will send details of students to the respective institution along with Roll No/ Registration No. The Principal will send result to the Board office before the commencement of examination.
4. Students, who change center or migrate, their result will also be prepared by teacher of the institute, in which the student has been studying from the beginning.
5. Migrated students from other Boards will only solve (40%) theoretical paper of practical and the remaining marks will be awarded by the same ratio. Students, who have failed before 2019 or want to improve marks/division, will also go through the same pattern.
6. Students, failed after 2019 or students seeking improvement will only attempt 40% of the practical paper and the rest of the marks (Practical part) will remain the same, which have been awarded to them in the annual exam by their institute.
7. In <sup>HSC</sup>matric, every teacher, who conducts practical exam of his/her class, will be paid Rs.30/- per student, per subject by the Board. Lab contingency and postal charges will be paid to the Head of the institution with previous rates.
8. If in any institution, teacher for the related subject is not available, head of that institute will himself/herself arrange the required teacher, for the conduct of practical. Payment will be made as described in S. No.7.
9. Board office will provide bill forms for payment. After filling, signing and countersigning, the concerned teacher(s) will send the same to Board office through head of the institute.
