- 11. The candidates are not allowed to bring/use mini-computer/calculator and mobile telephone sets in the Examination Hall. Unfair Means Case shall be registered against those who violate the above or such other instructions as are issued.
- 12. The candidates must reach examination center at 1:30 pm. No candidate will be allowed to enter examination hall after 2:00 pm
