Undergraduate Semester Exchange Program for Pakistan

The United States Educational Foundation in Pakistan (USEFP) is pleased to announce the 2022 Undergraduate Semester Exchange Program for Pakistan.

The program is intended to promote mutual understanding between the people of the United States and the people of Pakistan. It provides full-time undergraduate students from Pakistan the opportunity to enrich their education and experience through one semester of full-time, non-degree academic study in the United States. The program will also expose students to the principles of social responsibility in the United States through a community service component.

Eligibility Criteria

- Pakistani citizens
- 25 years or younger
- Currently enrolled in a college or university in Pakistan and committed to returning to their home university following the completion of the program.
- In their 18th or 19th year of formal education
- Applicants are required to submit current/most recent, and old transcripts with application

Ineligibility

- Dual U.S./Pakistani nationals or U.S. permanent residents
- Those who have a parent or spouse who is a U.S. citizen, permanent U.S. resident, or has a pending U.S. immigration
- Employees of the Fulbright organization, the U.S. Department of State, or USAID and their spouses, children, family, siblings, dependents, and parents
- Students in their final year of university

Women, people with disabilities, and individuals from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, A.J.K, Gilgit Baltistan, Balochistan, Northern Sindh, and Southern Punjab are highly encouraged to apply.

- Monthly maintenance allowance

Eligibility Criteria

Pakistani citizens

25 years or younger

Currently enrolled in a college or university and committed to returning to their home universities following the completion of the program.

Strong leadership qualities and potential in their university and community activities

Serious interest in learning about the United States

High level of academic achievement, as indicated in grades, awards and reference letters

Proficiency in English

Students from diverse backgrounds, especially those students who have not previously had opportunities to travel internationally are encouraged to apply

How to apply

The Global UGRAD-Pakistan program is advertised every year (please check for availability) by September/October. The application form is required to be submitted online. All supporting documents, such as photocopies of transcripts including an explanation of the grading scale of the university issuing the degree, are to be attached to the online application before submission. Scan copies of all your university attested transcripts must be uploaded online including the most recent transcript.
