

**CIRCULAR.**

It is notified for the information of all eligible failure students of 13 to 19-Batches that Supplementary Examination of First Term-First Year (1st Term) (13 to 16-Batches) & 1st Semester 1st Year (17 to 19-Batches) Bachelor of Engineering and Bachelor of Science shall be held from **Monday, the 12th July, 2021.**

Note: However, this shall be the **LAST CHANCE** for the eligible failure students of 13-Batch and for those students who were initially admitted with 13-Batch but were re-admitted with lower batch(es).

Accordingly, all the eligible students of above said-Batches of QUEST Nawabshah are required to fill-in their Examination Forms and pay the requisite Examination Fee in the University Account No. NIDA-11 through Bank Challan within due dates as mentioned below:

NOTE: -

1. The eligible failure students are required to attach TWO copies of their recent PHOTOGRAPHS duly attested by the Chairman of the concerned teaching department/Co-ordinator BS(CS) evening program alongwith attested photocopies of their ENROLMENT CARDS with their Examination Forms, failing which the Examination forms shall not be accepted.
2. The students without ADMIT SLIP shall not be allowed to appear in the examination
3. The appearance of INELIGIBLE candidates in the Theory /Practical Examination shall be illegal; as such the result of concerned subject(s) shall automatically stand cancelled without issuing any letter.
4. The examination fee deposited after the announcement of the examination schedule shall only be acceptable, whereas, the Bank Challans deposited prior to announcement of examination schedule shall not be entertained.

Note. Special Instructions for Students & Staff. 1. Students / Candidate will be allowed to enter in the examination hall only wearing facemasks. 2. Before entering to examination hall all are advised to wash/ sanitize hands. 3. Social distance of at least 3'-0" (three feet) shall be maintained. 4. Gathering at entrance or in examination centre be avoided. 5. All invigilators/ staff must perform hand hygiene frequently with soap and water or hand sanitizer. 6. Avoid handshakes/ hugs. 7. Other safety related precautionary measures and SOPs advised by Government of Sindh
