Fatima Jinnah Women University is geared towards contributing in the sustainable development of the country. The Times Higher Education (THE) Impact Ranking is a global ranking that assesses participating universities' impact on society in line with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). This overall Impact Ranking puts FJWU in the **9th place** among **Top 10 Pakistani Universities** out of a total of 36 Pakistani universities ranked by Times Higher Education in 2021.
