- Students awaiting the result of the final semester/year in their 18-year education are eligible to apply for PhD programs provided that they have passed all previous semesters/years with a minimum of 3.00 CGPA in the semester system or 1st division in annual system.
- All such admissions will be offered on a provisional basis, which will achieve the status of regular admissions when the awaited results with the required percentage/GPA are provided.
- If a student fails to achieve the minimum eligibility after the declaration of the final result, his/her admission will be deemed cancelled.
