



NOTICE FOR CLEARANCE OF OUTSTANDING DUES

This is to notify all students who have outstanding dues, as reflected in the University's official fee records, that they are required to clear all outstanding amounts on or before 23rd April 2026 without any further delay.

In this regard, the University has already taken the following measures to inform concerned students:

1. Formal letters have been issued to students' registered postal addresses.
2. SMS notifications have been sent to registered mobile numbers.
3. The relevant letters have also been uploaded on the student portal.

Students are advised to take this matter seriously, as non-compliance will result in strict action in accordance with university regulations and the policies of the Higher Education Commission (HEC), Pakistan.

Please note that non-payment of dues within the prescribed timeframe may lead to the following consequences:

1. Students will not be considered as registered for the current semester.
2. Course registration (including regular, supplementary, and summer sessions) will not be permitted.
3. Access to classes, LMS, and all academic activities will be restricted.
4. Students will not be allowed to appear in mid-term/ final examinations.
5. All student services will be suspended, including but not limited to:
 - a. Issuance of Student ID Card
 - b. Issuance of Transcripts (Semester/Combined)
 - c. Issuance of Degree and Pass Certificates
 - d. Issuance of Character and Bonafide Certificates
6. In cases of continued default, the University reserves the right to suspend or cancel admission without any further notice.

Students are once again strictly advised to clear their outstanding dues within the given deadline to avoid serious academic and administrative consequences.
